Police Complete Investigation into Alleged Sexual Assault

San Diego – The San Diego Police Department has completed its investigation into the alleged sexual assault that occurred off-campus near San Diego State University in October 2021. While no arrests have been made, the findings of the investigation have been submitted to the San Diego County District Attorney's Office for review.

The goal of any criminal investigation is to develop the most comprehensive set of facts and evidence possible. Since the initial radio call, SDPD has made this criminal investigation a priority. SDSU's continued compliance with SDPD's October 28, 2021 request to delay their Title IX administrative investigation helped ensure the integrity of this very complex criminal case.

SDPD's Sex Crimes Unit used all tools at its disposal to work this case. Since taking the initial report, more than 20 investigative personnel contributed to this extensive investigation, requiring nearly 200 hours of overtime.

SDPD's investigators have worked in cooperation with the San Diego County District Attorney's Office to obtain and execute 10 different search warrants. Detectives have interviewed multiple witnesses, examined physical evidence, and reviewed more than three terabytes of digital evidence. The San Diego County District Attorney's Office will determine if there is enough evidence to file criminal charges that can be proven beyond a reasonable doubt.
